## Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute & Hospital Striving Forward in Meeting Growing Demands of Eye Care

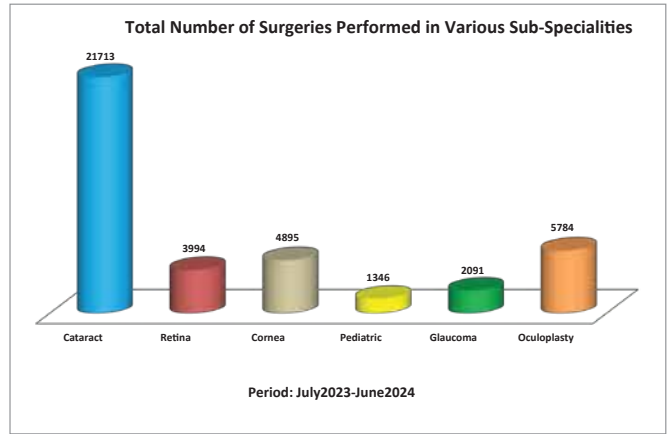
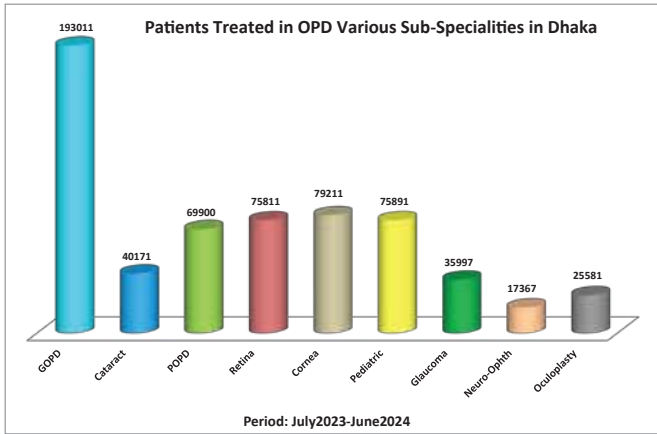
Ispahani Islamai Eye Institute & Hospital (IIEI&H) is coping well with the growing demands of the eye patients, both here in Tertiary Level Hospital in Dhaka and the branch hospitals located in Barishal, Jamalpur, Naogaon, and Kulaura, Sylhet. The skilled set of doctors, well supported by the trained optometrists, nursing staffs, counselors, paramedics, and other clinical and non-clinical staff members have rendered outstanding services in the field of

eye care and earned the utmost satisfaction from the patients.

The Medical Services, with the support of retina, oculoplasty, and cornea subspecialties in particular has contributed enormously in treating the bullet-injured patients affected during the students' anti-discriminatory movements in July-August, 2024. More than 200 surgeries were performed by our expert surgeons, while around 500 patients were treated in the outdoors. Members of nursing, community services, and outpatient support services departments have managed these patients efficiently.

## Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute & Hospital observed 'World Sight Day 2024' in its Main Hospital, Branch Hospitals and Primary care centers.

Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute and Hospital observed World Sight Day 2024 to show respect to a million blind people globally, on October 10, 2024, aiming to raise awareness about eye care. The theme for World Sight Day 2024 was "Children, Love Your Eyes". The theme for 2024 highlights the importance of eye health for children, and the need to make eye health services accessible, affordable, and available to all children. The theme also aims to raise awareness of vision impairment and blindness and promote eye and vision care. IIEI&H observed the day at its premises in Dhaka. The event was attended by the Director of community services, Deputy director of medical services, Coordinator of cataract training programs, and hospital doctors, optometrists, nurses, and other staff.

Ispahani IIEI&H also observed 'World Sight Day 2024' in its three Secondary Eye Hospitals, one Branch Hospital, one Surgery Center and 17 Primary care centers with the theme 'Love Your Eyes' with a special focus on 'Caring Your Children Eyes'.

The base hospitals at the district level and eye care centers at upazila level observed 'World Sight Day 2024' with elaborate programs like colorful rallies, advocacy/discussion meetings, and screening of the people on the spot as well. The local government authorities, including Civil Surgeons, Deputy Civil Surgeons, Upazila Nirbahi Officers, Upazila Health & Family Planning Officers (UHFPO), Doctors, Nurses, Optometrists, and other government and non-government officials joined those programs at district and sub-districts level in our working area in the country. A total of 55 events were arranged to observe the day and around 1,622 people attended those programs.

Centering the World Sight Day 2024, the Community Services department of IIEI&H had planned for a two-month-long (September-October 2024) screening program to reach a total of 120,046 patients through 745 screening events at the grass-root level in 12 districts in the country where IIEI&H has total 22 service delivery points. It is noted that finally, 22 service delivery points of IIEI&H have screened a total of 151,615 people in the area through 839 screening events in the community around the period. Among them 109,984 were adults and 41,631 were children. Detailed information of the achievement of screening events and WSD'24 observance is given below:

### Penetrating Keratoplasty of Patient with Pseudophakia along with Decompensated Cornea & Deep Stromal Vasculization: A Case Report

Md. Mozibur Rahman, a 58-year-old man came to our hospital from Madaripur district with the chief complaint of decreased vision in his right eye for around one and a half years ago. He had cataract surgery in his right eye 18 months ago in another hospital. In the initial diagnosis, we found that he had visual blurring and visual acuity of counting fingers in his right eye and left eye with 6/18. The final diagnosis was pseudophakia with decompensated cornea along with deep stromal vascularization in the right eye and cataract in the left eye. It was decided to do Penetrating Keratoplasty in the right eye. He had done Penetrating Keratoplasty in his right eye on November 4, 2024, at IIEI&H. The postoperative visual acuity of the patient's right eye was 2/60.
