**Phacoemulsification training (Phaco)**: The program is an intense 3-week surgical skills transfer course, targeted at ophthalmologists who are able to perform Small Incision Cataract Surgery. A fair competence with tunnel, rhexis and hydrodissection is expected. Intense training for nucleus management is given. The program is supported by didactic lectures, model/animal eye surgery in wet lab and structured supervised hands-on surgery. The experience and education in surgery is enhanced by observing senior consultants during surgery.
